UNDER THE RADAR

SLEAFORD MODS – INVISIBLE BRITAIN + Q&A (CERT TBC)

Part documentary, this feature follows the Nottingham post-punk duo **Sleaford Mods** on their recent UK tour, visiting neglected areas that many would avoid. The film combines live footage and interviews, taking a look at how individuals and communities are campaigning against austerity.
