## MAPPLETHORPE: LOOK AT THE PICTURES (18)

The first definitive, feature length portrait of the controversial American artist **Robert Mapplethorpe** since his death from AIDS in 1989. Intimate revelations from family and friends are topped only by Mapplethorpe's candor, revealed in a series of rediscovered, never-before-heard interviews.
