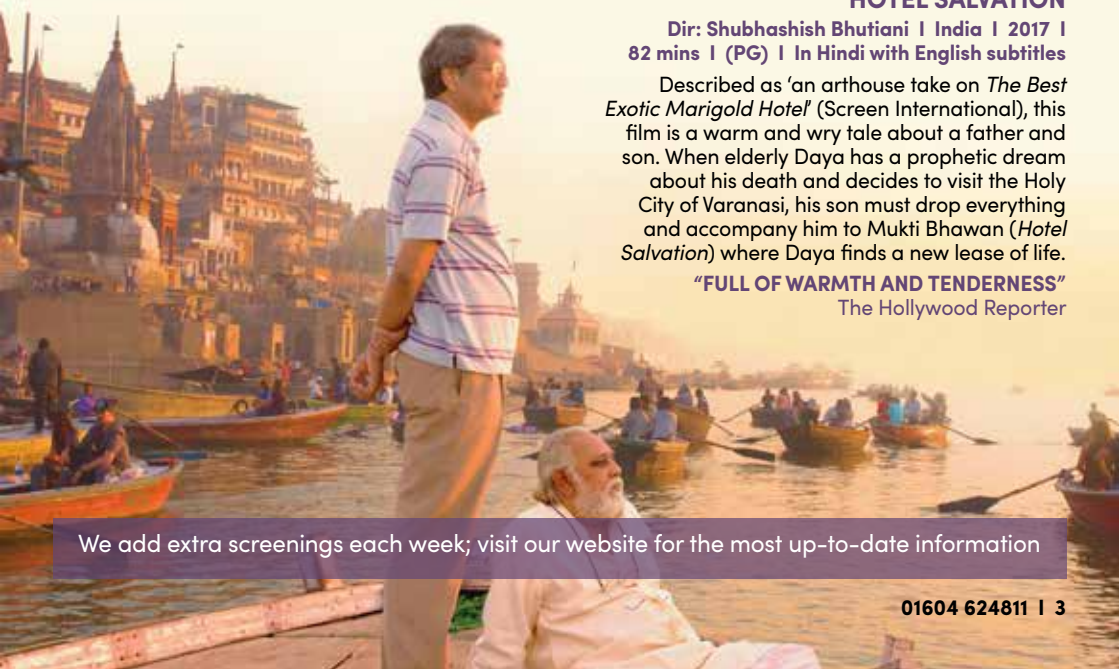

This thriller stars **François Cluzet** (*Little White Lies*) as a middle aged and financially struggling man who is looking for work two years after suffering a burn-out. He gets hired by a mysterious employer to transcribe phone taped conversations, which propels him into the heart of a large-scale political plot and gets him trapped in the French secret services underworld.

Jamie Bell, **Mark Strong** and **Abbie Cornish** star in the true story of how, in April 1980, six armed gunmen stormed the Iranian Embassy in Princes Gate, London, taking 26 people inside hostage. Over the next six days a tense standoff took place, while a group of highly trained soldiers from the SAS prepared for a raid, the likes of which the world had never seen before.

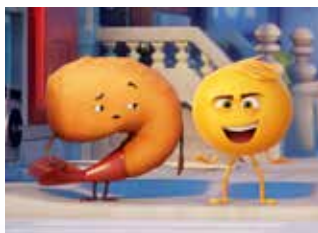
