At one time one of the most famous authors in England, Wilde's star has fallen. As he lies on his death bed, the past comes flooding back to him, transporting him to other times and places.

When Eric (**Rob Brydon**), a middle aged accountant, seeks to win back his wife Heather (**Jane Horrocks**), he stumbles upon a surprising solution in the form of a male synchronised swimming team: Men Who Swim.

## THE BREADWINNER

Dir: Nora Twomey | Ireland | 2018 | 94mins | (12A)

11 year old Parvana (**Saara Chaudry**) lives with her family in a one room apartment in Kabul, Afghanistan, which is under Taliban rule. When her father is wrongfully arrested, she cuts off her hair and dresses like a boy to support her family. From director **Nora Twomey** (*The Secret Of Kells*), the film was nominated for Best Animated Feature Film at this year's Academy Awards.

With the imaginative spirit of its heroine, this romantic period drama brings to life the world of a trailblazing woman who defied convention and channel her innermost demons into a legend for the ages.

When the trial begins against the two suspects, a young couple from the neo-Nazi scene, Katja is pushed to the edge. There's simply no alternative for her: she wants justice. The film won the award for Best Foreign Language film at this year's Golden Globes.



## LEAVE NO TRACE

Dir: Debra Granik | USA | 2018 | 109mins | (PG)

Her first feature film since 2010, Oscar-nominee **Debra Granik** (*Winter's Bone*) directs this deeply affecting drama about a father (**Ben Foster**) and his teenage daughter (**Thomasin Harcourt McKenzie**) who are forced into social services after living off the grid for years.

## ANCHOR AND HOPE

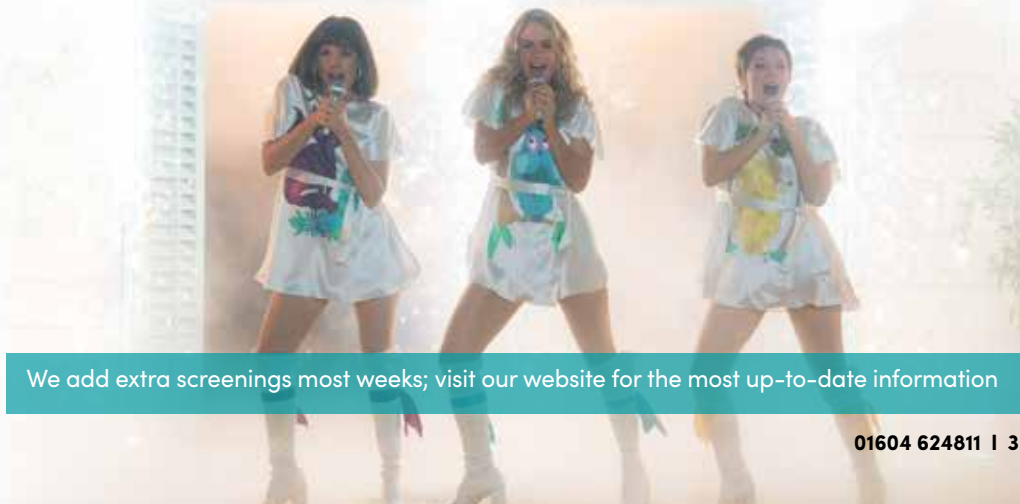
Dir: Carlos Marques-Marcet | Spain | 2017 | 113 mins | (15)

This award-winning comedy stars **Oona Chaplin** (*Game Of Thrones*) as Eva and **Natalia Tena** (*Harry Potter*) as Kat, a couple coming to terms with the death of their cat when Kat's close friend Roger (**David Verdaguer**) comes to stay. Eva is not best pleased to have the gregarious, womanising Roger impinging on their space, but then she hits on a plan that will bind the three of them together.

## PRESSURE

Dir: Horace Ové | UK | 1975 | 110mins | (15)

Hailed as Britain's first black feature film, *Pressure* is a hard-hitting, honest document of the plight of disenfranchised British-born black youths. Set in 1970s London, it tells the story of Tony, a bright school-leaver, son of West Indian immigrants, who finds himself torn between his parents' church-going conformity and his brother's Black Power militancy.
